FFL PA: Analyst briefing takeaways

Fauji Foods Limited has conducted its analyst briefing to discuss financial results and future outlook of the company. We have highlighted following key takeaways from the briefing:

- In CY23, FFL's revenue clocked in at PKR19.8bn vs. PKR12.4bn in SPLY, up by 60% YoY. Moreover, company's PAT clocked in at PKR605mn in CY23 which includes deferred tax income of PKR596mn. To highlight, company has been bottom-line positive from consecutive 10 months.
- Company's gross profit increased by 207% to clocked in at PKR2.9bn in CY23 vs. PKR0.9bn in SPLY, mainly attributable to process optimization, energy efficiencies & packaging localization. To highlight, company managed to save PKR1.0bn through these cost reduction initiatives.
- In the UHT milk category, the company has achieved a remarkable growth of 92% YoY whereas LTW declined by 33% YoY marking total FFL growth of 60% YoY.
- Company's value added portfolio has posted growth of 102% YoY, with Karachi posting the highest increase of 143% YoY in the metro regions.
- Company highlighted that they have significantly expanded their outlets from 18,000 in 2021 to 35,000 in 2023. While concurrently reducing their footprint from 269 towns to 91 towns.
- On acquisition of Fauji Cereal, management commented that it has been approved by BOD. They further highlighted that acquisition would be financed through convertible debt from shareholder at zero cost for initial 2 years.
- On future outlook, management mentioned that they are targeting to achieve an annual revenue of PKR100bn in next five years.
